Minimum Qualifications:

United States Citizen
18 years of age for Emergency Communications positions
21 years of age for Law Enforcement positions
High School Diploma or equivalent
Valid Virginia Driver's License
Good Financial Standing
Character Beyond Reproach

Automatic Disqualifiers:

DUI within the past five years
Any felony or serious misdemeanor conviction(s)
Domestic violence conviction(s)
Conviction for crimes of moral turpitude
Illegal use of schedule I/II narcotics within past five years
Any use of hallucinogens

Law Enforcement Application Process:

1. Fill out County Application (link below)
2. Fill out Personal History Statement
3. Physical Agility Test (only for non-certified applicants)
4. Polygraph
5. Psychological Examination

Emergency Communication Application Process:

1. Fill out County Application (link below)
2. CritiCall Test
3. Fill out Personal History Statement
4. Polygraph
5. Interview
6. Observation of the center and how it operates
